PHYSICAL THERAPY

We provide outpatient and inpatient physical therapy services utilizing the latest techniques and equipment available to achieve the highest level of independence. Treatments include individual therapeutic exercise, nu step cross trainer, gait training, ultrasound, electrical stimulation, diathermy, massage, balance activities including the Wii Fit Balance board and joint mobilization with emphasis in neuromuscular and orthopedic rehabilitation. Our therapists have been specialty trained and certified in the use of modalities to decrease pain and accelerate healing. Further certifications include senior-strength training and athletic training. We offer group therapy options such as music exercise and lower extremity exercise groups to allow for peer interactions and increase patient motivation.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Occupational Therapy assists our patients in regaining functional independence by focusing on activities of daily living such as self-feeding, bathing, dressing, grooming, and domestic skills. They also target upper extremity gross/fine motor skills strengthening and ROM, visual perceptual activities, and balance to include use of the Wii Fitness program, and hand splints or adaptive equipment as needed. Our therapists are specialty trained and certified in the use of modalities to decrease pain and accelerate healing. Specialty certifications include Lymphadema and Craniosacral treatments. We provide both inpatient and outpatient services as well as therapeutic group options including yoga, and laughter exercise groups.

SPEECH THERAPY

The Speech Therapy department provides a full range of services to treat a variety of communication disorders, cognitive impairments, and swallowing deficits. Specialty certifications include the Lee Silvermann Voice Training program for vocal deficits, specifically those associated with Parkinson's disease. Vital Stimulation and Deep Pharyngeal Neuromuscular Stimulation are available treatment options for both inpatients and outpatients experiencing severe dysphagia. We are anticipating the provision of Fiber optic Endoscopic Evaluations to be utilized onsite to more accurately guide treatment plans, allowing for efficiency and safety of diet upgrades. Specialized therapeutic computer programs may be used to improve attention, language, and cognitive deficits while challenging and motivating patients.
